The seventh and final part of the group project that is due is the *final draft* of your paper. Here are the parameters:

- It is due on Wednesday, December 8, at 4:45 PM.
- If your group is using its one free late assignment for the final paper, you can have an extra 24 hours. Turn it in by Thursday, December 9, at 4:45 PM. This is only for groups that haven't yet used their "free pass" earlier in the semester.
- The final paper counts for 70 points (out of 120 points for the total project).
- Each group should upload one electronic copy to Canvas **and** should turn in one hard copy.
- To submit your hard copy, you have two options. You can bring it to the CEE department office (ENC 3300), time-stamp the paper, and ask the student helper to put it in my mailbox. Or, you can just slide it under my office door (ENC 3215) before the due date.
- If possible, I will set this up as a "group assignment" on Canvas, which makes it easy for each group to submit one paper. However, in my experience, Canvas won't let me set up "group assignments" if we are also using TurnItIn (the plagiarism detection software). Therefore it might appear to be an individual assignment on Canvas. However, each group should only submit *one* file, so your group should decide which member will be the person who submits it. (If multiple students submit the paper, then TurnItIn will think that you copied from each other. So just have *one* student from the group submit to Canvas.)
- Format and length should adhere to the guidelines described previously. Use APA style, including double spacing. See the "sample student paper" on pp 61–67 of the APA guide.
- You must cite at least 10 sources/references. Web sites don't count towards your 10. You must give complete bibliographic citation for your references, using proper format (APA format) for the citations. The references can be the same ones you submitted previously, or you can make changes from your previous list.
- Your final papers will be evaluated using the ENV 4001 writing rubric (50 points) and the ABET Outcome 4 Rubric (18 points). The final 2 points will be awarded automatically if you follow all the guidelines and instructions and submit your work on time.
- **Plagiarism will result in a grade of 0/70 for all group members**, and may incur additional penalties for academic dishonesty. In the past, some students have had to re-take the class because of plagiarism on the final paper. **Do not plagiarize.**
