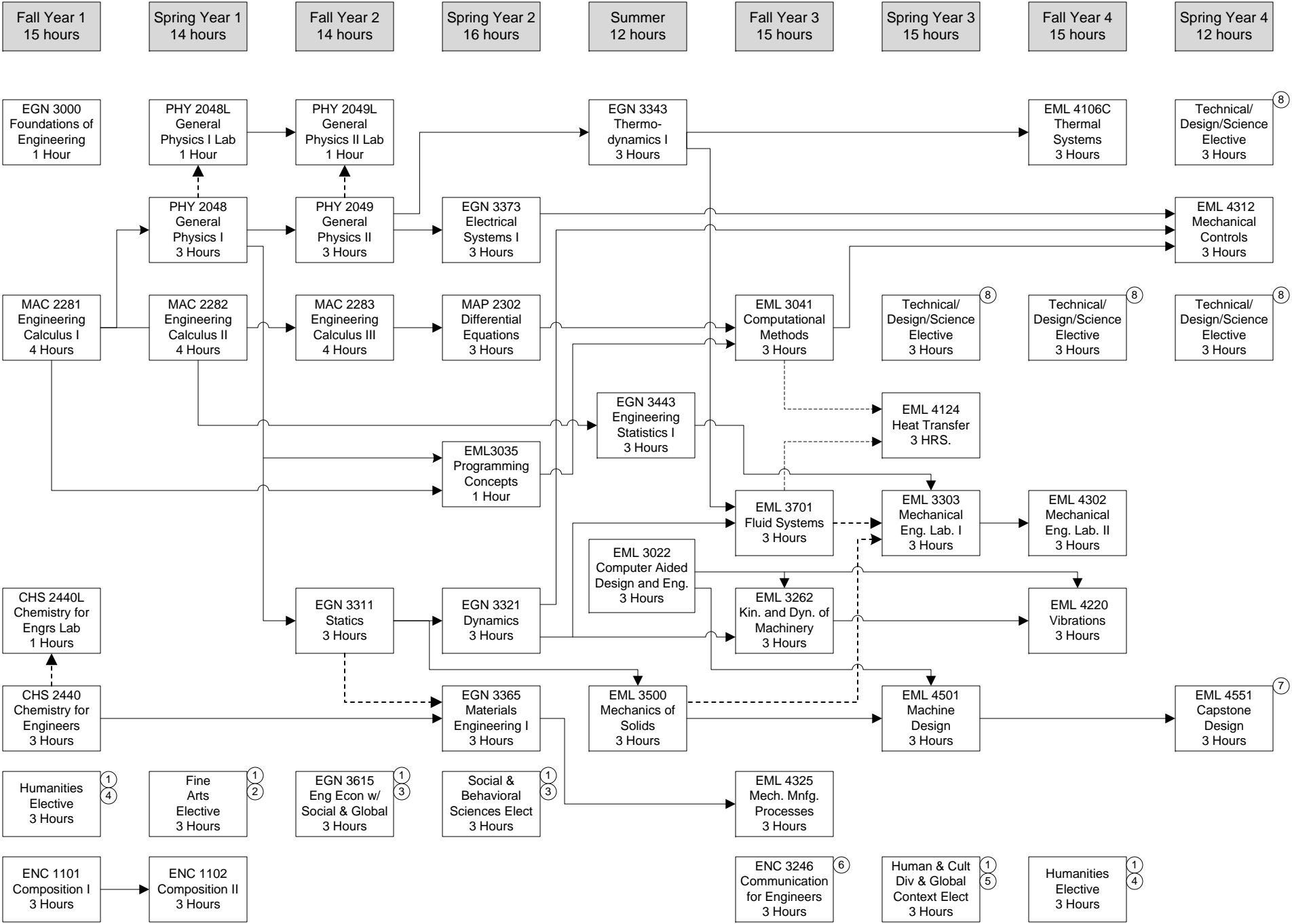


# USF Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering (B.S.M.E.) Fall 2011 Catalog, 128 hours

3. Any approved Social and Behavioral Sciences Elective from the undergraduate catalog may be taken, however, the Department requires the following course to satisfy 1 of the 2 Social and Behavioral Sciences Electives:  
EGN 3615 – Engineering Economics with Social and Global Implications
4. Any approved Humanities Elective from the undergraduate catalog may be taken.
5. Any approved Human and Cultural Diversity and Global Context Elective from the undergraduate catalog may be taken.
6. This course satisfies the USF exit requirement “Writing Intensive”. It must be taken at USF.
7. This course satisfies the USF exit requirement “Capstone”. It must be taken at USF.
8. Students must choose four courses from the approved technical/design/science electives.
