Grading in a Flipped Class

The final course grade is determined as

Course Grade=Avg Grade ×Engagement Factor

The engagement factor range is from 0.900 to 1.1. Your engagement factor depends on how well you engage with the course. These include the following items and are weighted.

- 1) Attendance
- 2) Canvas pre-class quiz scores
- 3) Canvas pre-class online adaptive lesson scores
- 4) In-class exercise scores
- 5) Metacognition assignment scores
